Since 1862, the railway has had a varied history through many eras of operation and ownership and is today one of the biggest tourist attractions in the county. Joseph Rogers is a former employee of the railway and current volunteer who has assisted the Commercial Department of the railway since 2018. He is also the author of <i>Railway Enthusiasm in Twenty-first-century Britain book</i>
25-Jun	To A Mountain in Tibet	Geoff Saunders	Travelling overland through China in 2002, I learned of the construction of the railway to Lhasa and determined that I would take that train. Construction delays and political upheavals prevented me making the journey until 2014. The mountain in question is, of course, Everest. Though the railway does not itself go there, the journey from Nepal took in the North base camp and continued to Lhasa where I boarded the train. Two days later, having crossed the highest railway pass in the world, I arrived at Chengdu, with its Giant Pandas, continuing by train through southern China to Hong Kong. History, geography, nature and politics all feature in the talk.

13-Aug	The Great Northern Railway & Kings Cross Station	Raymond Schofield	'York was the gateway to the north and just 2 years after the London & Birmingham Rly - Britian's first mainline, opened; York was connected to the rail network. The route, from Euston via Rugby, Leicester and Derby was 40ml. longer than the A1 road. Twelve years later in 1852 a new direct route from King's Cross opened. Built on the site of a former smallpox hospital and alegedly Boudicca's grave, this offering tells the story and journeys the route with steam locomotion"

27-Aug	Railways Around Dawlish	Philip Haines	My presentation entitled 'A Dawlish Journey' will start with shots of steam locos around Dawlish in the late 50's / early 60's then look at the Hydraulic era during the late 60's / early 70's before moving on to the Diesel Electrics in the 80's. We then look at Hi8 video sequences taken in 1998 and conclude with digital footage taken in 2023. The presentation is divided into 4 parts, the first looking at early shots then two parts looking at 1998 footage and the last part the 2023 footage.
10-Sep	A History of DMU'S	Colin Boocock	was launched in early 2013 and covers all types of diesel railcars and multiple units that have ever operated on the main line railways in the British Isles. The history starts on the LMS in 1927 and leads through a number of blind alleys before following the development of GWR railcars and their successors in Ireland. The sheer variety of early diesel railcars is surprising. British Railways' first and second-generation DMUs appear, as do more modern types in the UK and Ireland. Privatisation brought further UK developments leading to the longest and the fastest diesel units on our system. Be surprised at the sheer variety, and the complexity of DMU history, made clear in this fascinating show.
24-Sep	The Hampshire Community Rail Partnership	Mark Miller	I shall provide a summary and presentation on the development of Hampshire Community Rail Partnership over the past 3 years.
